This Cookie Policy explains how Levitate Data FZCO ("Levitate Data", the "Company", "we", or "us") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on any website that we own, license, or otherwise operate and that links to this Cookie Policy (each, a "Site"). This Cookie Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, which describes more broadly how we collect, use, and share personal information.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer, smartphone, or other device when you visit a website. Cookies set by us are called "first-party cookies"; cookies set by parties other than us are called "third-party cookies." We also use related technologies such as web beacons, pixel tags, and similar identifiers (together with cookies, "Cookies"), which perform similar functions.

2. The Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following categories of Cookies on the Site:

Category	Purpose	Examples of Providers
Strictly Necessary	Required for the Site to function, including security, network management, and remembering essential preferences. These cannot be switched off through the Site.	Levitate Data (first-party); our hosting providers
Analytics and Performance	Help us understand how visitors use the Site (pages visited, time on page, errors) so we can improve it. Data is used in aggregate form.	Our analytics service providers
Advertising and Social Media	Placed by our marketing partners to measure the effectiveness of our campaigns and to show you relevant messaging about our Services on other platforms.	LinkedIn (Insight Tag); other marketing partners

3. Third-Party Cookies and Pixels

Some Cookies on the Site are provided by our marketing partners, including social media companies such as LinkedIn. These partners may use the data collected through their Cookies in accordance with their own privacy policies and terms, and may combine it with other information they hold about you. For more information about the LinkedIn Insight Tag, please review LinkedIn's cookie and privacy documentation on its website. We do not control third-party Cookies.

4. Your Choices

Most web browsers allow you to refuse or delete Cookies through your browser settings. Please note that if you disable Cookies, some parts of the Site may become inaccessible or not function properly.
